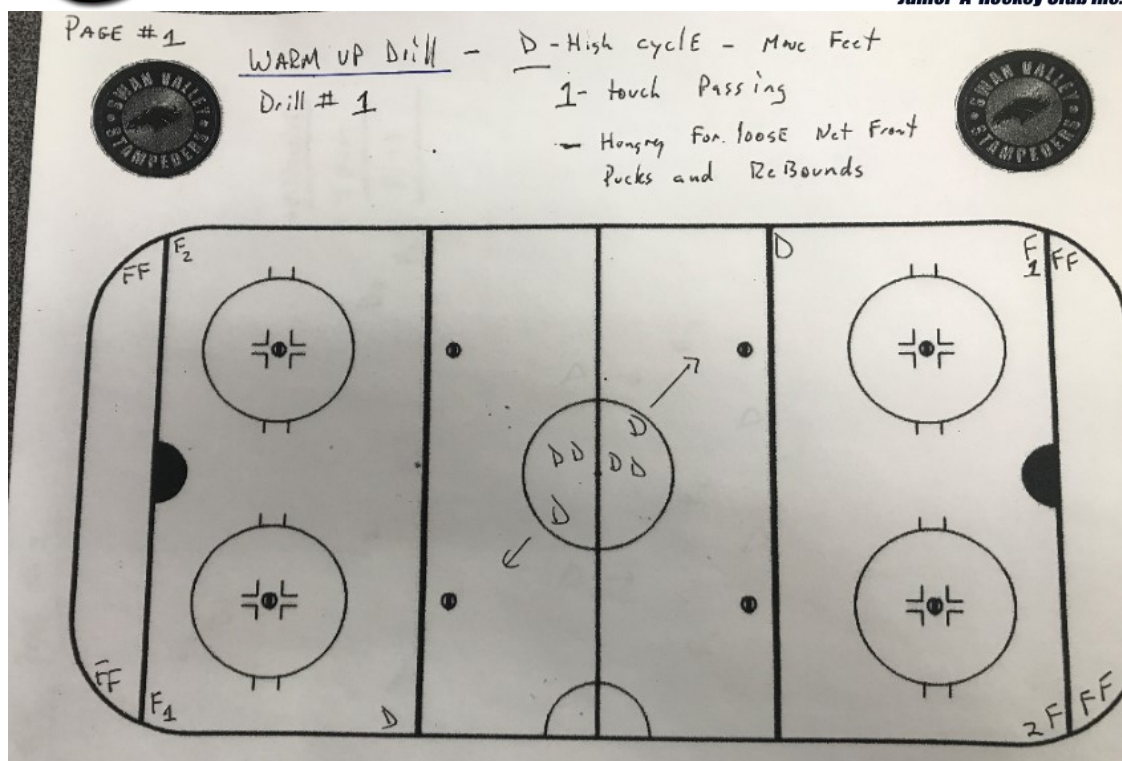

DRILL #1 –Drills Page #1 Warm Up Drill –

Forwards in all 4 corners, D-men in the middle, drill rotates sides every time,

On whistle- F2 takes puck to dot, wrist shot goes to the net looking for loose pucks
Rebounds off the other side –(d-shot-then F1 shot)
Then F2 is finished back to a line.

On Same Whistle, D leaves center circle, hard to Blue line, stops, F2 leaves corner with puck, pass's to D man-who 1 touch's puck back to F2, F2 carries puck high to create D high cycle, F2 waits on blue line, as D man skates down wall, shooting far pad from wall hash marks, for F1 to play rebound,

F2 gets a pass from the corner they left from, fake shot drag on Blue line, wrist shot to net, F2 and D play rebound,

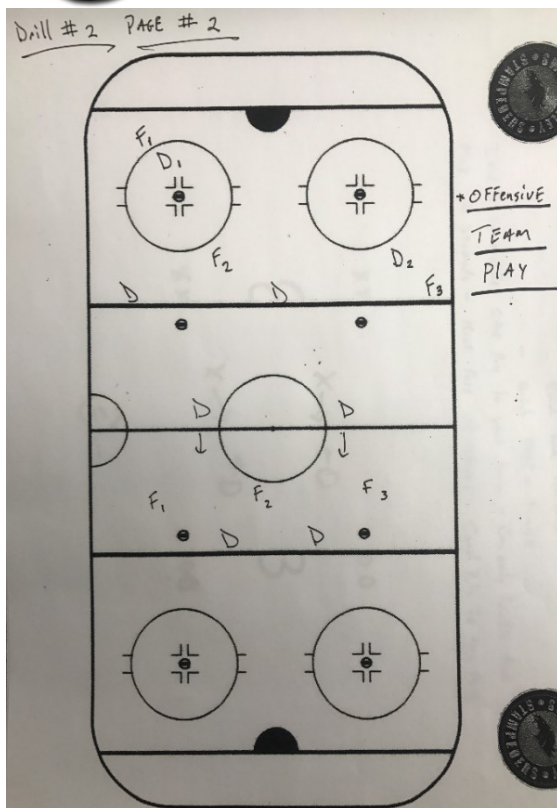
D then gets a pass from same side corner, F1 gets into break out wall position, D pass to F1, who makes 1 touch pass back to D, can be a flat pass option (D-skates toward F1)

Both F1 and D skate towards far end, D- pass back to F1 before offensive blue line, F1 shoots from above top of circle, goes to the net, for a screen deflection off a shot the D takes, (D stops on Offensive blue line, allows F1 to finish their part, then receives pass from F corner) fakes drags wrist shot on net. Switch sides

DRILL #2—Drills Page #2 Offensive Team Play

One Forward line,(3 forwards) 4 –dmen 2 each side,

On whistle F1-push's puck to corner, goes after it with D1 attacking, finishing hit, F2 activates same time and talks to F1, to create a 2 on 1, in hopes of F1 pushing puck to open ice for F2 to retrieve and take to the net for scoring opportunity, on a goal or a whistle,

that activates F3 who 1 touch's to D2, D2 back to F3, who attacks the net, Or can pass to either F1 or F2, creates a fast 3 on 2, in hopes of creating scoring opportunity in a hurry, can work on all cycles, corner, net, high slot.

On a goal or a whistle, coach spots a F a puck who attack 3 on 2 to the far end, the 2 D that just defended the end zone, activate to the offensive side and push up ice to join the rush,

-Can work on net drive, attacking the seams with speed, offensive zone entry's, flat pass option, hitting the D as a 4th man on the rush.

Looking for opportunity's to score off the rush, which means puck needs to get to the net quickly.

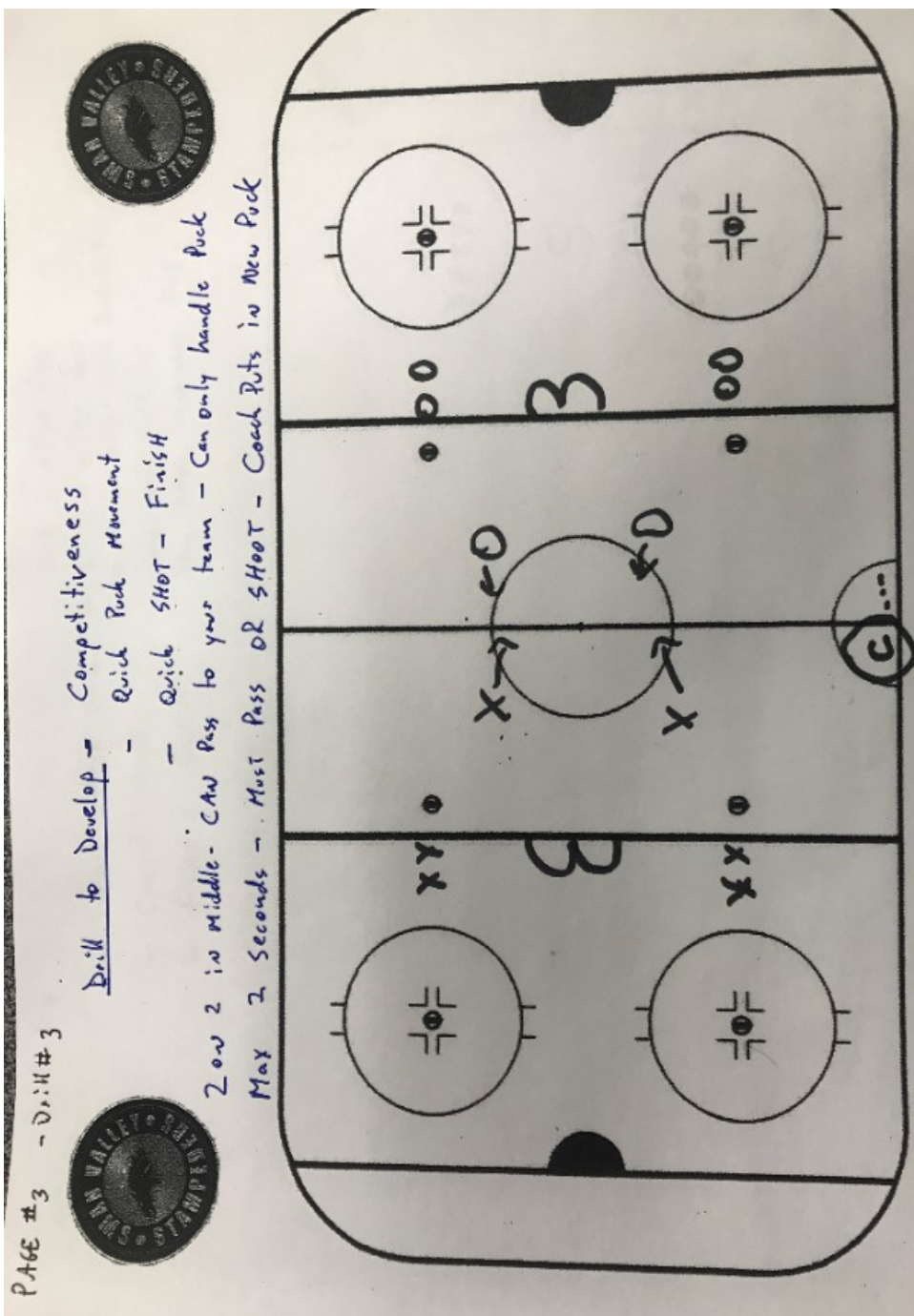
Play it till a goal or it is time, next group is set up and ready to go at far end. They start on your command
